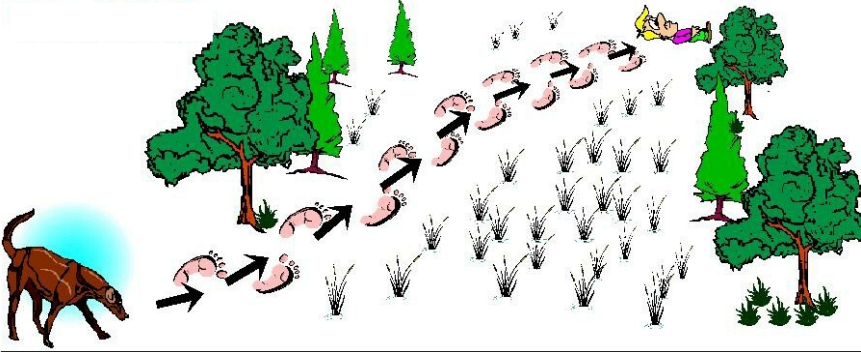

Are you looking for something fun to do with your dog? Why not try tracking? It is fun for both dog and owner. Tracking is where dogs follow human scent and receive a positive reward for doing so. Tracking training helps to develop your dog's problem solving skills and will provide much enjoyment and exercise for both you and your pet. Progression in tracking skills will enable you to compete in various tracking competitions.

Dave Walker of Command Response Dogs has been training Working Dogs, Police Service Dogs, Search and Rescue Dogs, CKC Competition Tracking, for over 25 years. He is an internationally certified police dog trainer and judge. He is also a Volunteer Search and Rescue Dog Training Coordinator/Handler for a local police service and provincially certified under OSARVA/OPP.. Dave will share his experience with you and your dog so that you both will be able to enjoy the fun and rewarding experience of tracking.

The course is designed for the pet owner who is looking for something fun to do with their dog. Both the Seminar and Workshop will also be of interest to both novice and experienced tracking teams. All breeds are welcome and have to be at least four months of age.
